

The AVHOFS Scholarship program recognizes Arizona veterans who are permanent residents attending institutions of higher learning in the State of Arizona. We acknowledge Patriobarn, Youth and Education while serving Arizona veterans.*

Scholarships offered range from \$2000 to \$5000

- Be honorably discharged veterans, active duty, or service members in good standing with a Reserve or National Guard component.

VA Camp Lejeune Information

VA has established a presumptive service connection for Veterans, Reservists, and National Guard members exposed to contaminants in the water supply at Camp Lejeune from August 1, 1953 through December 31, 1987 who later developed one of the following eight diseases: Adult leukemia; Aplastic anemia and other myelodysplastic syndromes; Bladder cancer; Kidney cancer; Liver cancer; Multiple myeloma; Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma; & Parkinson's disease. HB 2062 Vehicle license tax exemption for PH veterans:

On registration of a vehicle, if the veteran submits



satisfactory proof to ADOT that the person is a veteran and a bona fide purple heart medal recipient and was honorably discharged vehicle registration tax fee is waived. Can only be used on one vehicle. Specialty plate and personalization fees still apply.

Arizona PH license plates were first issued in 1988.

Three Tucson veterans receive Purple Heart auto license plates

Three Tucson veterans were among the first in Arizona to receive Purple Heart license plates during ceremonies yesterday at the Veterans Administration Medical Center.

Marie Lenze, of the Arizona Department of Transportation, presented the special license plates to Donald Dingee, 56, who was wounded in Korea, and Jack Ayers, 59, and Garner Hooper, 66, who were wounded in Vietnam.

A state statute passed this year authorized the Motor Vehicle Divison to produce a distinctive license plate for veterans awarded the honor.

The plates have a white background, purple letters, and a replica of the Purple Heart medal.


The awards were presented during Veterans Day ceremonies that included a parade through down-town Tucson.

"It's a great honor. It separates a particular class of veterans," Hooper said.


"It's indescribable. To have something like this is really an honor. I think it expresses what Arizonans think of its veterans," Hooper said.

Dingee said the plates were the result of "a lot of long, hard efforts by a lot of veterans." State Sen. James Henderson, D-Window Rock, "deserves a lot of credit," Dingee said. Henderson sponsored the bill.

Applications for the plate may be presented at all vehicle license offices, with proof of receiving the medal. The fee for the special plate is \$25.
