Every third Friday of the month, Veterans Affinity meet at the Arizona State Veterans Home – Phoenix (4141 S Herrera Wy, Phoenix, AZ 85012) to serve coffee, donuts, and camaraderie with the Veterans living there who can join us. Some of us already make similar visits to Veterans around the State but if you are looking for another opportunity, join us for an hour or so at 0945 one of those third Fridays. Double the Donation Incentive: We have all been bombarded with advertisements these last couple of weeks to "make a difference." In my opinion, every one of them represents great causes and they all need help. Our Order needs help also, even though we don't have fancy advertising campaigns or nationally known spokespersons. Our National programs are mostly accomplished at the grass roots level - individual members and Chapters. The American Dreams Program (https://mophfund.org/ambassador) is currently the Order's primary nationwide fundraising program. Homeowners can be come Ambassadors at the \$100 level getting access deep discounts at national companies specializing in products to refresh or remodel homes. In many, but not all cases, the discounts are even more than we get as Veterans. Ambassador registrations can be gifted to ANY homeowner and ANY homeowner can become an Ambassador. Out of each registration, \$50 will be donated to our National programs and \$25 will be donated to the Chapter designated during registration. This program could generate \$1,500 for each Chapter if they recruit only five (5) new Ambassadors each month for one year. Remember, ANY homeowner can become an Ambassador. Throughout January, the Department will double the donations to our Chapters.



Purple Heart License Plates

HB 2062 Vehicle license tax exemption for PH veterans: Many of our members are still not aware of this benefit. On



registration of a vehicle, if the veteran submits satisfactory proof to ADOT that the person is a veteran and a bona fide Purple Heart medal recipient and was honorably discharged vehicle registration tax fee is waived. Can only be used on one vehicle. Specialty plate and personalization fees still apply.

Private School Tax Credit

Patriot Joe Kobes' son Hudson is a sophomore at Brophy College Preparatory High School in Phoenix. If you are so inclined to support this program and could use another tax break on your AZ taxes, you can contribute on Hudson's website for the tax donations:

For any private school Arizonans can allocate a tax credit to a student at a private school, and it will cost them year's National Wreaths Across America Day -Saturday, Dec. 14, 2024!

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- This is only for veterans' wreaths sponsored through a registered WAA Sponsorship Group - so if you are a 3-for-2 group, you will only get the paid wreaths matched, not the third free wreath. For \$5 back groups, you will not get the \$5 back on the free matched wreath. And of course, regular no plan group sponsorships will be matched as well!
- The match will only be honored on checks dated and mail postmarked during the 12/16/23-1/16/24 timeframe. If checks are submitted outside this timeframe, the wreaths will not be matched.



Recipe of the Month



Smoked Turkey by Department Commander Keith Gray (reprinted from the November 2020 Newsletter.

Ingredients

- Turkey (15lbs or less)
- Spices to taste
- Smoker (electric, charcoal, gas, pellet)
- Wood Chips (prefer apple, cherry or hickory for turkey)
- Meat thermometer.

Directions

1. Preheat smoker to 225 (F)

2. Prepare turkey how you normally would for roasting.

3. Place in smoker once prepared and seasoned to taste.

4. Smoke for 27 min per pound or until internal temperature of 165 or greater

Note:

I use a sweet glaze which makes the skin darken. 1/8 cup molasses

1/8 cup brown sugar

¹/₄ cup honey

on the compliance of military discharge review boards to follow statutory requirements related to the liberal consideration standards in the review of discharge status and requests for correction of military records based on mental health conditions to include post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), sexual assault or sexual harassment. This legislation calls for a more liberal review of other than honorable (OTH) military discharges for the purpose of eligibility for Department of Veterans Affairs benefits and services in cases where veterans may have been suffering with PTSD, traumatic brain injury, or experienced military sexual trauma or harassment. Urge your senator to support this legislation.
