Puskar Veterans Scholarship (\$5,000) is funded by the Department of Arizona Military Order of the Purple Heart and awarded annually to a veteran selected by the Arizona Veterans Hall of Fame Society. The 2nd annual Puskar Veterans Scholarship recipient is **Sierra** Mattos. She is a seven-year US Navy veteran. She served as a Korean Linguist with tours of duty in Monterey, CA, South Korea, and Hawaii. She is pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Speech and Hearing Science at Arizona State University. Her goal is to become a Speech Language Pathologist. The scholarship was presented at the Arizona Veterans Hall of Fame Patriotic Luncheon in April. Congratulations Sierra! This scholarship is named in honor of U.S. Marine Corps Captain Robert J. **Puskar** who fought gallantly during the siege of Khe Sanh and at Dong Ha, Vietnam from 1967 to 1968. 

Bills in Congress

The Stuck-On Hold Act (H.R. 6656) would reduce wait times for veterans making phone calls to the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). The bill would require the VA's telephone call line to include an automated response system that would do two things: 1) advise the caller of the anticipated wait time and 2) offer the caller the ability to receive a callback if the wait time is excessive. The Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA) has 992,344 pending claims. One claim generates approximately eight separate contacts to the call

centers. This means that VA could expect eight million calls this year. Veterans are having to wait on the phone for an extended period of time to receive assistance or the latest information about their claims or appeals.

We ask you to contact your Representative and urge them to co-sponsor and support H.R. 6656.

H.R. 5530, the VA Emergency Transportation Access Act, would limit the VA's ability to change payment rates for transporting veterans and eligible individuals on specialized transportation modes. Government reimbursement rates for certain types of highly specialized emergency transportation have been significantly lower than the true costs of providing such services. The VA finalized a proposed rule change to cut its reimbursement rate for emergency air medical transportation. During health emergencies, this reduction could put an estimated 4.7 million veterans living in rural and remote communities, who already struggle to get reliable access to health care, at greater risk. Contact your representative and urge them to cosponsor and support H.R. 5530, the VA Emergency Transportation Access Act.

H.R. 6452, the Veterans Scam and Fraud Evasion Act, or the VSAFE Act, is legislation that would establish a Veterans Scam and Fraud Evasion Officer in the Department of Veterans Affairs. Over 74,000 military retirees and veterans reported instances of fraud or identity theft last year, resulting in a loss of \$350 million in earned benefits. The VSAFE Act aims to provide our nation's veterans with consistent guidance on how to identify, report, and avoid fraud and scam attempts. Additionally, this bill promotes identity theft resources, calls on the VA to develop training plans to effectively field fraud and scam inquiries, and fosters coordination with other federal departments and agencies.

H.R. 5247, the Expedited Hiring for VA
Trained Psychiatrists Act of 2023, aims to reduce
wait times for veterans seeking mental health care
by allowing the VA to establish a fast-track process

Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) noted in 2023,
